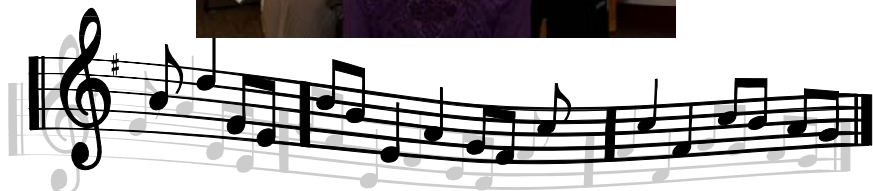


## **SYLPH CHAMBER MUSIC WITH CRYSTAL SINGING BOWLS CONCERT**
